



92Y Residence Rules and Regulations:

COVID-19 Amendment

We would like to welcome you to 92Y Residence! In order to provide a safe living environment for our residents during these unprecedented times, we have made additions and amendments to 92YResidences Rules & Regulations.

General Precautions to Be Adhered to:

- Residents must wear a facemask, or face covering, at all times when in communal areas throughout 92Y
- There can be a maximum of 3 residents in an elevator at a time
- Maintain social distancing (6 feet were possible)
- Please wash your hands frequently for 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer which is located throughout the building if unable to wash your hands
- If you have a fever or do not feel well, please notify the Residence Office and consult with your physician on next steps
- May Center memberships are suspended until further notice
- Day or overnight guests are suspended until further notice

In Your Room

- Housekeeping services will be suspended until further notice
- Clean linen can be picked up from the Residence Office on your designated housekeeping day.
- Please place dirty linen in provided bags and drop off in designated bins on your floor.
- Cleaning supplies can be borrowed from the Residence Office
- Trash bags for your room can be picked up from the Residence Office and you can discard your trash in the trash bins on your floor

Kitchen/Dining Room

- There can be a maximum of 1 resident in the North Building kitchen at a time
- There can be a maximum of 3 residents in the South Building kitchen at a time
- There can be a maximum of 2 residents in the North Building dining room while maintaining social distancing
- Please wipe down all surfaces (kitchen counter, range knobs/handle, refrigerator handle, freezer handle, tables, etc.) before and after use with provided disinfecting wipes
- Wash your dishes and utensils after using the kitchen and take back to your room. Anything found in the kitchen will be discarded immediately.
- Do not share dishes, drinking glasses, cups, or eating utensils
- Residents may only cook for themselves and not anyone else

Bathroom

- There can be a maximum of 3 residents in the bathrooms at a time while maintaining social distancing
- Avoid placing personal items (including toothbrushes) directly on the surfaces
- You are encouraged to use a shower caddy/tote to bring your personal items to the bathroom with you and back to your room

Laundry Room

- There can be a maximum of 1 person in the laundry room
- Please wipe down all surfaces on the washing machine and dryer before and after use with provided disinfecting wipes

Resource Room

- There can be a maximum of 2 people in the Resource Room at a time
- Please wipe down all surfaces before and after use with provided disinfecting wipes
- Open window to permit proper air circulation

Communal Area Cleaning

- Kitchens, bathrooms, dining rooms will be cleaned and sanitized at least twice a day or as needed throughout the day
- Stairwell rails and exit push bars will be cleaned and sanitized once a day
- Elevator button panels will be cleaned and sanitized twice a day

Temperatures will be checked upon entry to 92Y. If you have a temperature of 100.4 or greater, you're required to;

- Go to your room
- Strictly comply with 92Y Co-Vid-19 health and safety protocols as stated above (i.e.; wearing a mask, hand washing, disinfecting all surfaces after using, social distancing)
- Monitor your temperature and symptoms over the next day or two.
- If you have a continued fever, a cough, and/or loss of smell and taste, contact your doctor, or the residence office for a list of local healthcare professionals. For more info, visit [NYC 311](#).

If your test result comes back positive for CoVid-19, you're required to tell the Residence Department.

Being that 92Y Residence is in a communal setting and we are not able to offer direct medical support;

- 92Y will require you to make arrangements to return home or move to another location which could provide a more suitable environment for convalescing and/or [by calling NYC 311](#). If you need any assistance in making these arrangements, contact the Residence Department.
- 92Y will require you to immediately move to a designated room provided by 92Y while you arrange to return home, or to another location.
- If you cannot return home, or find another location to convalesce temporarily, please contact the Residence Department.
- If you choose not to move to the designated room within 92Y Residence, you will need to move out immediately.
- Credit/refund implications will be managed on a case by case basis.

As this situation changes rapidly, we reserve the right to make changes to these amendments and all 92Y Rules & Regulations as necessary.
